Press Release

The People's Majlis has amended and approved the Maldives Safe Tourism Guideline (MSTG) proposed by the Ministry of Tourism, during its 8th sitting of the second session held on 17th June 2020.

The guideline was incorporated with amendments proposed by Hon. Ibrahim Rasheed, MP for Central Maafannu constituency, Hon. Hassan Zareer, MP for Mathiveri constituency, Hon. Jeehan Mahmood, MP for Hinnavaru Constituency and recommendations by the Speaker of the People's Majlis. In addition to that, the Majlis passed to incorporate the following amendments to the guideline. They are:

- Not to impose any taxes or fees other than those levied prior to Covid-19 upon on-arrival tourists and flights to Maldives;
- The Government to establish a mechanism that allows tourists to visit the Maldives without being subjected to quarantine measures.

The People's Majlis has requested the President Ibrahim Mohamed Solih to share the recommendations with the Ministry of Tourism and facilitate a seamless, smooth process for the incoming tourists.
